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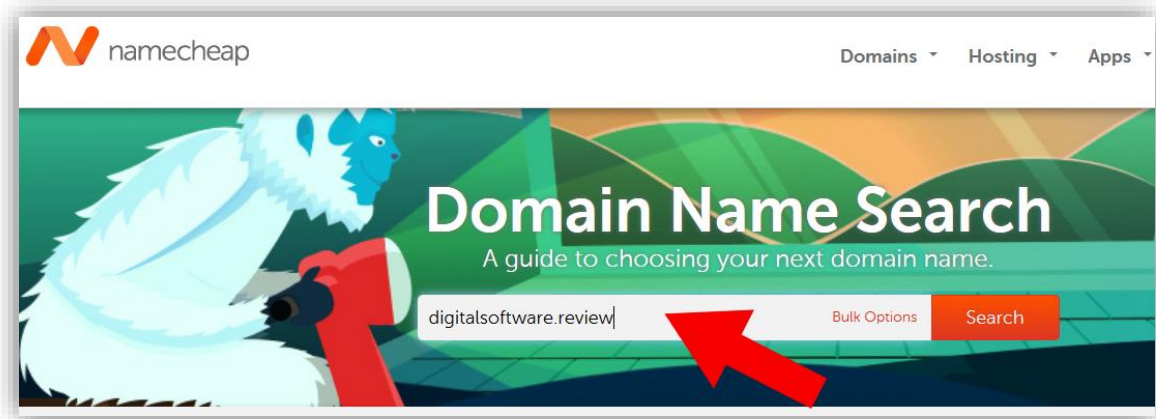

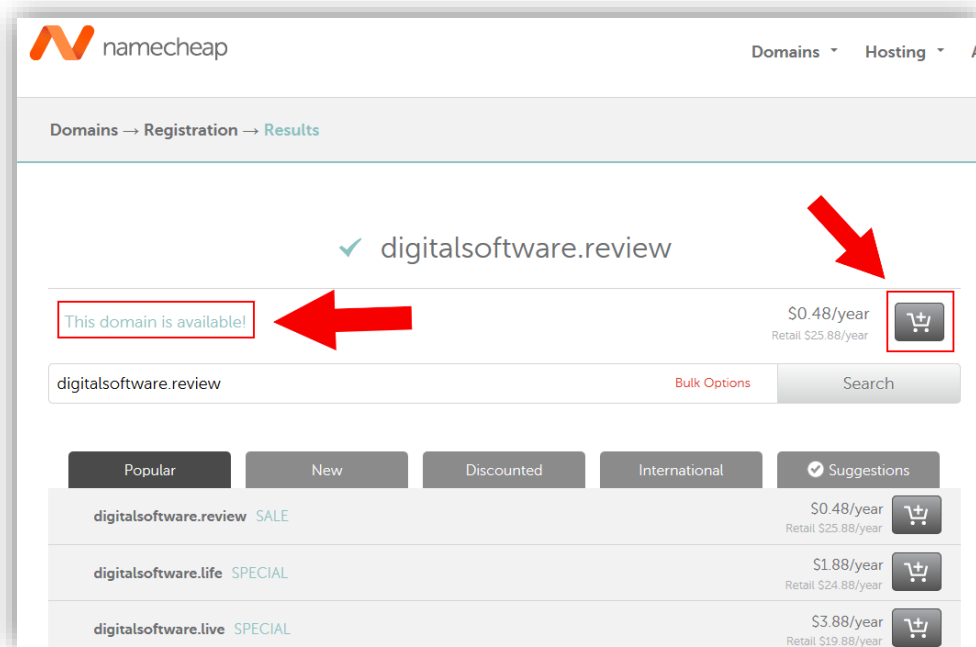
In this quick guide, I will show you how to register your domain with Namecheap and then connect your domain to your hosting account at A2 Hosting.

[Start by visiting the Namecheap Homepage Here](#)



In the search box, enter the name of the domain you want to register (always try and get the .com) and hit "Search".

I've gone for a .review domain since this website is only going to be used as a demo site for some of my guides, and not an actual income generating business.

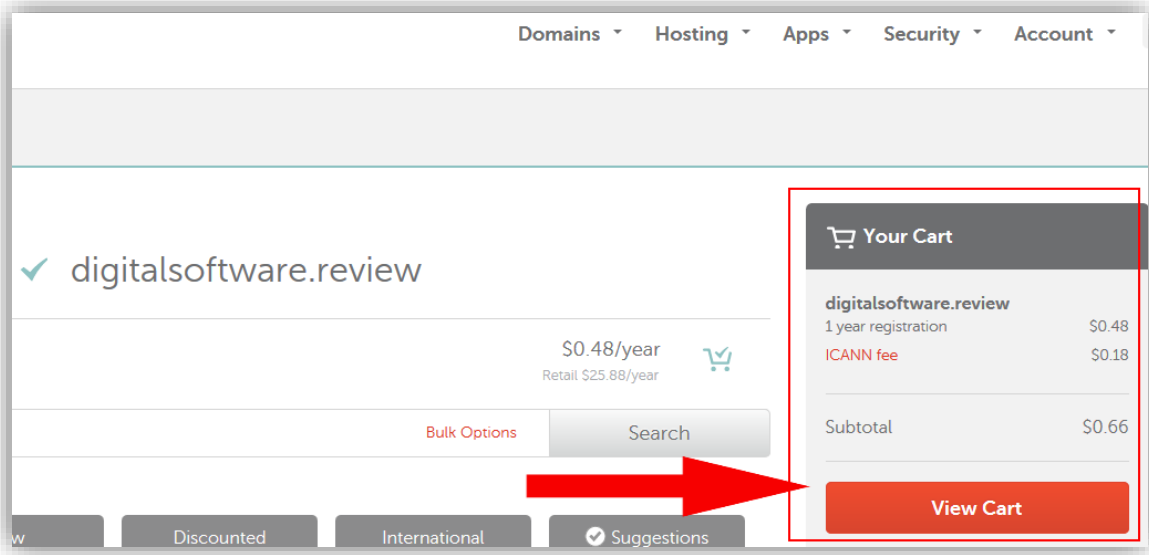


Namecheap will now check to see if your domain is available for registration.

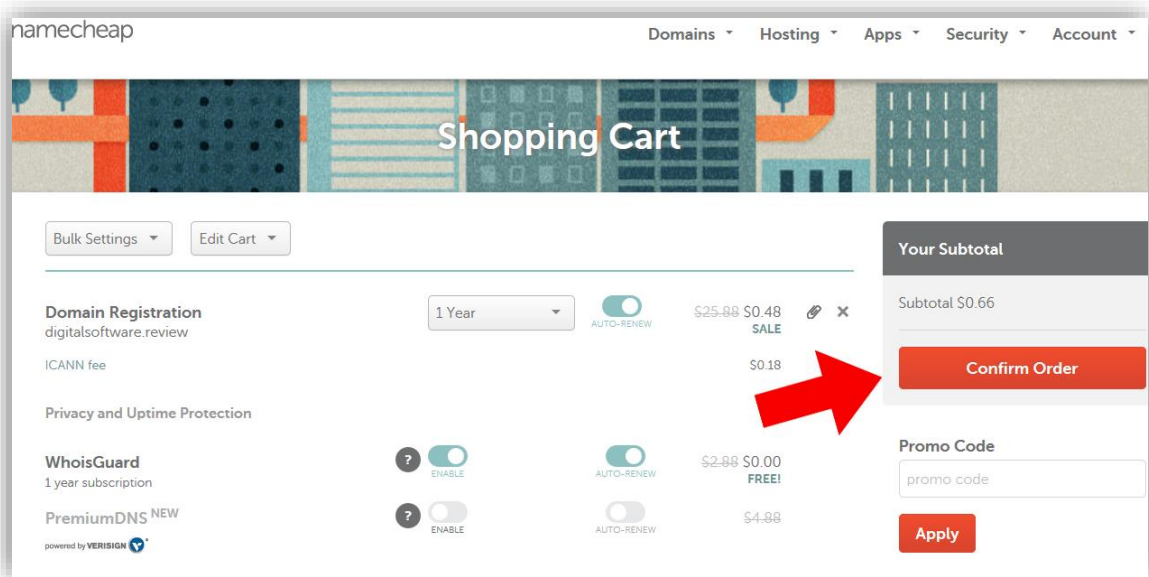
If it is, you can add it to your cart to purchase.

If it's not available, you'll have to come up with a different name.

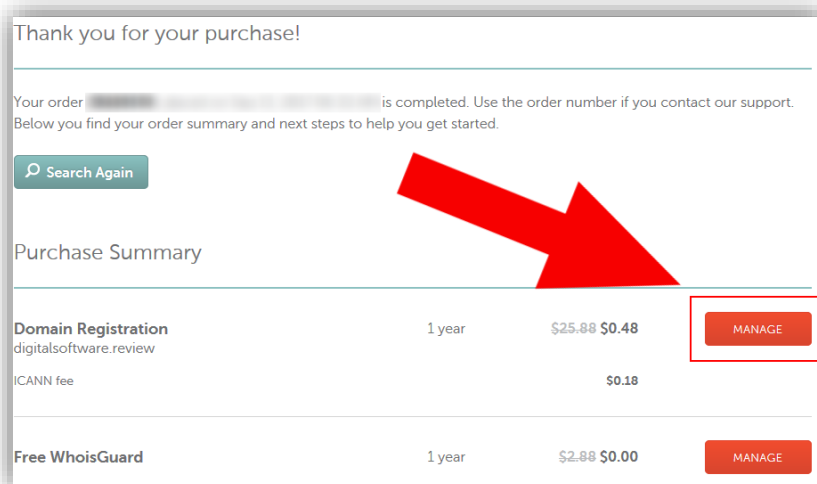
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Once you've added your domain to the cart, click on "View Cart"



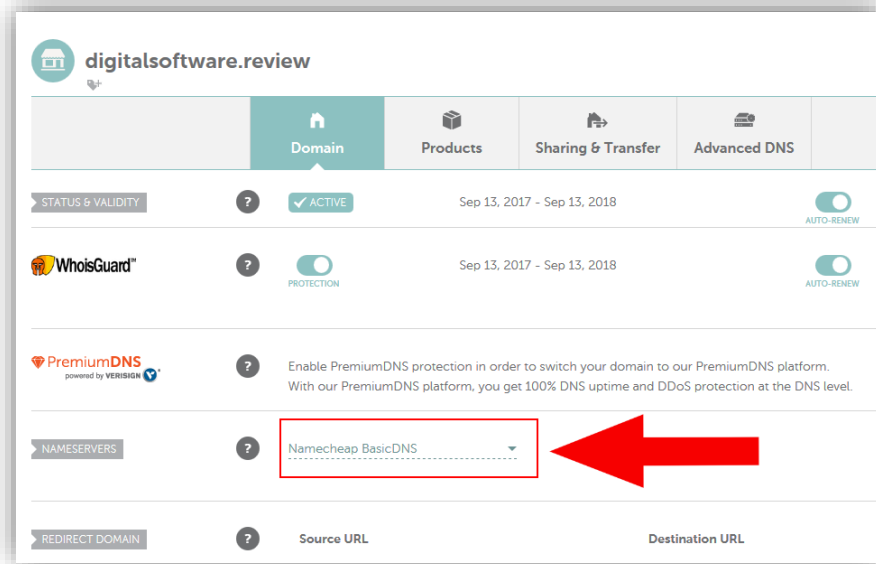
Click on "Confirm Order" and then you'll need to complete the purchase via Paypal or Card etc.



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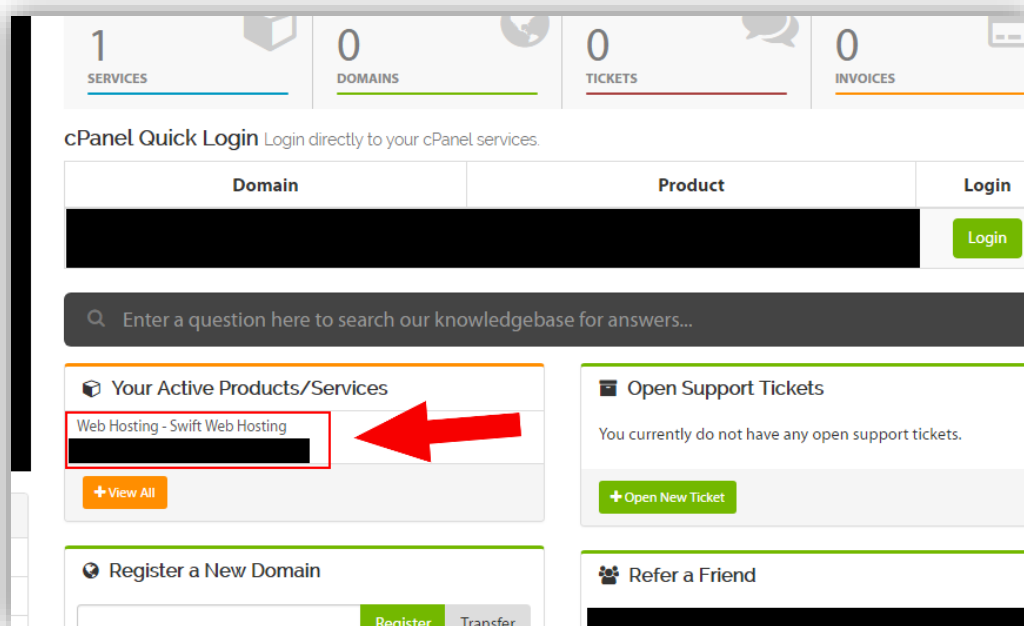


Once your purchase is complete, click on the “Manage” button as it’s time to connect the domain to your A2 Hosting account.



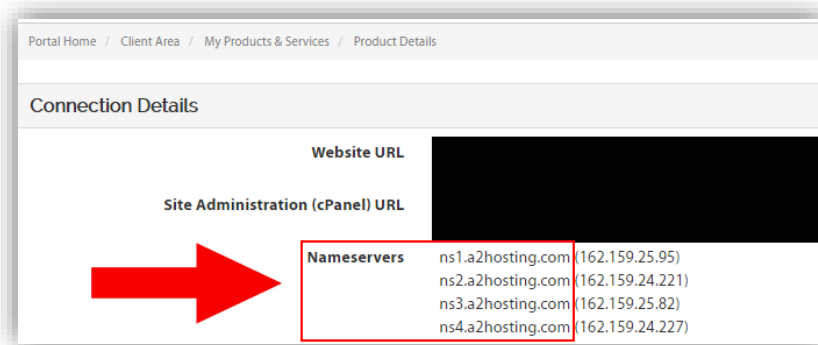
In order to connect the domain to your A2 Hosting account, you will need to change the Nameservers of your domain, from the default Namecheap Nameservers to A2 Hosting’s Nameservers.

To find A2 Hosting’s Nameservers, login to your A2 Hosting account.

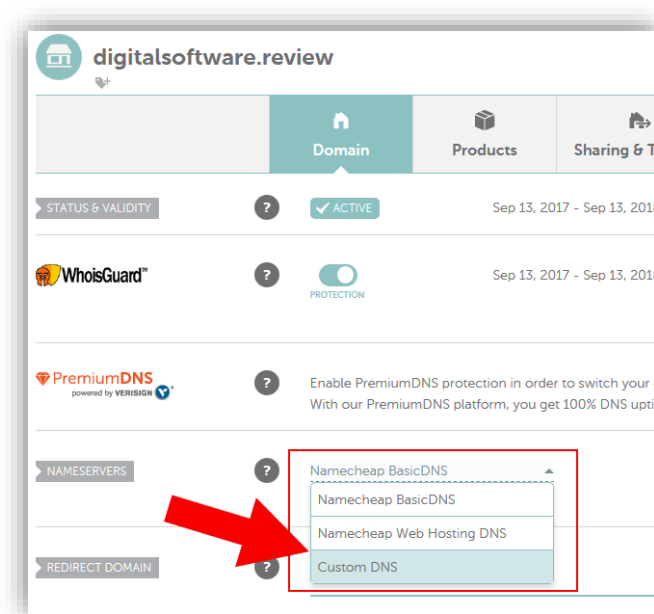


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Inside your A2 Hosting dashboard, click on your hosting package under “Your Active Products/Services.”



This will take you to the Connection Details screen of your hosting account. This is where A2 Hosting’s Nameservers are displayed.



In the Nameservers section of domain in Namecheap, click on the drop-down menu and select “Custom DNS.”



Enter in each of the A2 Hosting’s Nameservers and then save the changes.

Your domain will now be connected to your A2 Hosting account and you can proceed with building your website.

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
